The vineyard requires ongoing attention, but rest assured, the needs of the vineyard are being managed by Shneor and our viticulturist, Avinoam Inbar is never far away. Now we are in November, within the next month the vine will enter its dormancy period. When the temperatures drop below 10°C, the vine will lose its leaves. Our task is to ensure

that the vines will enter dormancy in the best manner possible, with enough energy stored and well-developed roots. We are still watering but gradually reduce this as temperatures fall. It is crucial the vine is in the best shape to enjoy a good dormancy period, so it has everything in place ready for when it is reborn in the spring.

One of the reasons we have been able to continue is due to our wonderful volunteers. Chief amongst these, has been Ha'Shomer Ha'Chadash.
